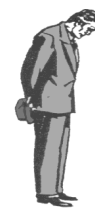

Observations

As I write this from Katmandu on Wednesday evening (Nepal time) I am excited about the fact that this is the last article I will write before returning to Alabama next Tuesday. Sunday, as you read this will be our last full day in South Asia for this trip. As much as we have enjoyed being here, Brenda and I are ready to be home and worship in "our pew" (whichever one has room for us) at Highland Park. We have really missed our fellowship with you and are getting pretty anxious to see you all again.

The trip has been great however. Our last week in Khulna was the youth conference and it was tremendous. Then we spent last week in the eastern part of Nepal, much of it well up in the Middle Hills of Nepal. Everything under 12,000 feet is called a hill, the mountains start from there. Some people are even more restrictive in their terminology – only those with permanent snowcaps (above about 16,000 feet) are considered real mountains ("Himals"). We "only" got up to about 7,300 feet this trip, all by car. We did not do any trekking. But we did visit with a lot of great Christians and had wonderful Bible studies and fellowships with them.

We traveled to the city of Dharan last Saturday stopping twice on the way to have Bible classes in two cities. Dharan is a vacation city for the Nepali people. There is a good congregation there with Kajiman Shreshtha as the preacher. Kajiman works under the oversight of our elders. He is doing a very good job. We stayed there through last night (Tuesday) teaching and visiting with them and in some nearby towns as well where we are seeking to plant churches.

Tomorrow (Thursday) we will show Ben some of Katmandu and prepare for more teaching. The rest of this week will be spent in teaching in three places. Ben, Brenda, and I will all go to Goldanga Friday where Ben and I will teach two lessons each. Saturday he and I will teach men's classes at Old Baneshwar while Brenda teaches ladies' classes at Subidhanagar. Sunday we will worship and preach at Thankot in the morning and Subidhanagar in the evening.

Monday of course will see us on our way back home. We ask for your continued prayers as we complete our trip here and as we travel. See you next week!!
