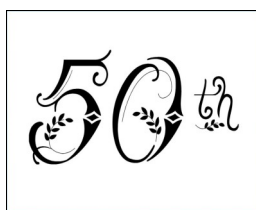

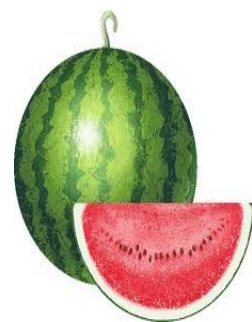
Ladies Fitness Bootcamp

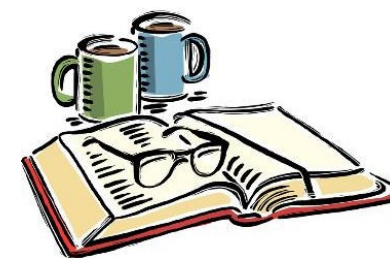
